### Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) Accepting Applications for Summer Learning Opportunities in Entrepreneurship, STEM

The <u>Appalachian STEM Academy</u> has pioneered access to STEM-related research opportunities for high school and middle school students and high school teachers across Appalachia for 30+ years. Students will collaborate with award-winning scientists at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory on guided group science, math, and computer science technology research projects, while teachers develop STEM-related curriculum with expert science practitioners. **Programming will be held at Oak Ridge Associated Universities in Oak Ridge, Tennessee.**
